



Supply List for Fall Special Term 2024

The minimum required materials are paper and a pencil. I made the class sample drawings with printer paper on a clipboard, a pink colored pencil (Crayola or Roseart or some such), a black Prismacolor pencil, and a couple of gray alcohol art markers. I use a box cutter as a pencil sharpener, too. If you wanted to follow along with my method and were buying all of those supplies brand new, it would look like this:

- Ream of paper - 9\$
- Clipboard - 3\$
- 2 colored pencils (light color such as pink or light blue) - 4\$
- 2 colored pencils (dark color such as indigo, umber, black). (A soft graphite pencil such as a 4B or 6B will do the job too.) - 4\$
- 4-5 warm gray alcohol markers in a range of values (optional) - 20\$
- White polymer Eraser (optional) - 1\$

That would amount to about 40 dollars, but you probably have some of those things already lying around. This class is mostly for time with the model, so whatever you enjoy working with - a sketchbook, newsprint, charcoal, ink, pencils - is just fine.
